

Sex Offender Committee

12 attendees (35 on committee). Discussion topics included-

- Most significant is the SB 121 – taking juveniles off the public registry at 17 and allowing them to petition the court 2 years misdemeanor and 1 years felony to be taken off registry.
- Adam Walsh Act requires all states to come in compliance by July, 2009.

Will require registration on a tier system

3 – Increase lifetime

2 – 25

1 – 15

Will require anyone 14 & up who is adjudicated for an offender greater than Agg. Crim. Sex Abuse to register as an adult on the public registry.

Thank executive board for their support with legislative changes. We have worked with AOIC and SOMB to develop a survey which will be sent to all departments inquiring as to how they handle sex offenders, both adult and juveniles.
